FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the financial report were available for review and comments. A motion by Mark Stedman and second by Sheryl Stedman accepted the treasurer's report. Co-treasurer Haugan recapped the last two events. Scott Kirby event donations were \$266.00. Performance fee was \$500.00 plus advertising of \$66.40 for a total of \$566.40. This did not include heat or lights. HOHS came up \$366.40 on the minus side of the ledger. The Pine and Cherry program donations totaled \$154.00 and expenditures of \$48.00 for speaker fees and \$70.20 for advertising leaving a surplus of \$35.80 not considering the heat and lights.

Snack table for these two events was \$54.00.

Santa photo sales with 29 settings totaled \$362.00 less Karen's expenses.

OLD BUSINESS

1) Fire extinguishers have been recharged and replaced at the following locations: stairways, stage, lobby, hall and Art Room for a total of 6.

2) Banner Fuel submitted a bid on replacing the gas furnace. He also measured and evaluated space for a furnace in the Art room and Rummage room.

3) Carol addressed the issue with rust on the roof of the elevator car. The main contractor will be contacted to look at the rust. A leak detection will show measurable water.

4) Winterizing the building, turning off water and draining the system was discussed. Carol will call for help if she needs assistance.

NEW BUSINESS

1) Selecting officers was mentioned. Co-treasurer Ed stated he was not going to do the job again next year. Co-Treasurer Sheryl stated the computer program she was given was not workable and she would need a new one.

No further action was taken.
