

Minutes
Harrington Opera House Society
June 2, 2013

The monthly meeting of the Harrington Opera House Society was called to order by president, Mark Stedman at 7:00 p.m. in the Art Room. Present were Mark and Sheryl Stedman, Linda Wagner, Ed and Bunny Haugan, Carol Giles, Marge Womach, Karen Robertson, Bonnie Hardy and Jen Smith.

The minutes of the May 5, 2014 meeting were read and approved as corrected.

Ed presented the treasurer's report as attached. He reported that we currently have \$17,811.39 left between two grants. May income translated into 18% from the Lions Club dinner that was served, 41% from donations, and 41% from music lessons. Music lessons netted \$770 in profit. June has outstanding general fund obligations of \$8,732. Ed requested that all bills be given to him in a timely manner. It was moved by Linda and seconded by Bonnie to approve the treasurer's report.

No report regarding the plaster for the south and east walls as Gordon was out of town. Jen will try to get the name of a special product to put on the brick for sealer.

A bid will be sought for the interior ADA ramp. It was reported that Billie had talked to Royal Upholstery regarding the stage curtains from EWU.

The new sidewalk will be sealed. Extra product was needed for completion of the project. It was moved by Linda and seconded by Bonnie to make an additional payment of \$586.96 to the Smiths.

Bonnie is working to have the handles on the new nickel plated. Carol and Bonnie continue their work on the Art Room.

Since the curtains are down for the time being, the light board in the auditorium will need to be moved so it doesn't get too hot. Linda and Bunny will cover the pews in order to avoid sun damage.

Carol continues to look for artisans to come to the art room.

No report regarding a presentation by Les LePere.

The Lions Club bbq dinner went well. 26 burgers were cooked by Jen.

September 13 will be the wedding of Dan Brown and Kitty Johnson-Woods along with a car show. Linda and Bunny will help coordinate it.

September 14 will be the Grande Interlude at 4:00 p.m.

October 10 Tayla Lynn and Eric Tingstad will perform. Ticket price is \$20 but it was moved and seconded to make blocks of 10 tickets available for \$17 each. Ed indicated that he had some interested from Inland Empire and Corbin Tours.

Approval was given for the October 25, 2014 wedding of Emily Oestreich and Brandon Miller. Linda will work with them.

Ed will pay our insurance premium. No report was given for the Wasmer-Education grant as Billie was out of town.

Karen will work on the advertising for the October 10 Lynn/Tingstad concert. She will also work with the Hardy's to promote Grande Interlude.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
